Guidance for Activities at TVUUC in Response to covid

Effective 1 September, 2022

The church remains open and will continue offering both in-person and online Sunday services. There are no restrictions on activities outside of the building, but for inside activities, precautions are based on the current CDC Community Risk Level for Knox County.

As we continue creating our new normal, we remember that:

- Masks protect others as well as ourselves.
- Some of us are not or cannot be vaccinated
- Some of us are immunocompromised, or live with or care for someone who is.
- People have differing levels of comfort with physical distancing.
- People with symptoms, a positive test, or an exposure to someone with covid should wear a mask, regardless of community risk level.
- Please stay home if you are feeling ill.

Precautions for Indoor Activities

High

- Universal masking for ages 2+ with the following exception:
 - Masking is voluntary for speakers while at a microphone.
- Singing only by the choir and performers.
- No food or drink inside.

Medium

- Universal masking for ages 2+ with the following exceptions:
 - Masking is voluntary for speakers while at a microphone.
 - Masking is voluntary for singers while performing.
 - Temporary unmasking while actively drinking or eating.
- Food/beverage are allowed only in the Fellowship Hall and the kitchen.

Low

- No COVID-related restrictions.

Implementation of the appropriate level of precautions should be effective immediately upon any change in risk level as updated weekly on the CDC's "COVID-19 by County" webpage¹
