

TVUUC Pledge Campaign for 2026-2027

In February of each year, the Tennessee Valley Unitarian Universalist Church (TVUUC) conducts a stewardship pledge campaign. In this process, we ask all Members and Friends how much money they hope to contribute to our church's operating budget in the upcoming fiscal year (July through June). By tallying these pledges, church leaders can plan and create a budget for the upcoming fiscal year. While we know that financial changes can occur and the estimated gift may have to be revised later, the pledge campaign provides our best estimate for next year's revenue and allows the church to plan accordingly.

TVUUC is a self-sustaining congregation that received no funding from regional or national Unitarian Universalist organizations. Donations from Members and Friends make up 94% of churches total revenue. That is to say, pledging and giving to the TVUUC operating budget is essential to the viability of our beloved church. We are our own keepers of the flame.

Remember that pledging is not giving. Once you make your pledge, you will arrange with the church office how the pledge will be paid: whether by bank draft, check, RMD distribution, or some other way.
